Executive Committee Report 2007

Contribution to community and our alma mater has been one of the missions of our alumni association. To celebrate the 10th anniversary of HKSAR and 70th anniversary of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, we have mobilized our alumni to participate in two events: Hong Kong-Shenzhen Western Corridor Walk for Millions in April and "Flags of Harmony and Unity" in September this year.

We have organized a team of 78 alumni and their families & friends to participate in the Hong Kong-Shenzhen Western Corridor Walk for Millions. Total HK\$43,110 has been raised for The Community Chest to support the "Children & Youth Services" to help the younger generation develop a positive value and cultivate their sense of social belongings.

A group of 45 alumni and companions joined the PolyU community in forming the largest human national and HKSAR flags and helped to break the Guinness Record of 21,726 participants.

Other activities organized or supported in the year include:

As at 31 October 2007, there are 322 registered members of which 146 are Joint Award, 130 are Warwick Award, 36 Associates and 10 with award status not yet identified.
